Mood - thunder/lightening = evil witches
Omen = weather

Simile - "as two ^{alliteration} spent swimmers"
plot device for dramatic effect

Simile/V. irony - as hare lion
as sparrow eagle

Allusion: - Golgotha - "place of the skull"
↳ Mood, setting



Bellona's Bridegroom - Allusion, Metaphor,
Alliteration → Characterization

Soliloquy - Alone on stage; speaking
your thoughts out loud

Aside - Short comment while the scene
is in play & others are talking

Monologue - Others on stage; 1 person
talking
